Developing the Total Athlete Educational Series: Each athlete will participate in three life skills sessions as part of the event's *Developing the Total Athlete Series* led by NBA and Kaiser Permanente health experts and supported by NBA and WNBA talent, covering the total health spectrum of mind, body and spirit in a culturally inclusive environment.

The session will share tips on how to approach tasks and challenges, including navigating adverse childhood and community experiences, and making the most of opportunities. NBA Player Development experts will share tips on how to build positive, healthy, and respectful relationships among players, coaches, parents, and referees. In turn, these skills will also help youth establish healthy practice schedules, nurturing relationships, and overall good character.
